Roundtable: Making Connections

Data, we all want it. But what do we do with it once we have it? How can we leverage existing technology and AI to better understand vision care trends, disease prevention and interventions. “AI’s purpose “is not to eliminate the ophthalmologist, but to enhance and increase access for patients,” said Robert Chang, MD, an expert in the field.² For example, the Los Angeles County Department of Health Services found that telehealth monitoring for diabetic retinopathy decreased patient visits by approximately 14,000 visits. With the inclusion of artificial intelligence (AI) to screening processes, the number of visits is anticipated to drop yet further. The algorithm will only need retinal pictures if an AI system is included into the screening procedure³. This roundtable will focus on ways the industry can work together to extract and examine data to provide better vision care outcomes.
